**Asbestos Services Flow Chart 2009**

Step 1: Asbestos Survey as per EPA National Emissions Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) protocol.

NESHAP Survey:

Required for renovation and/or demolition building activities. Survey may be required prior to submittal and/or approval of the renovation/demolition permit application from the local permit issuing agency. (Municipality, city or state) Survey is required in the event that suspect asbestos containing building materials may be rendered friable during those activities.

Step 2: Asbestos abatement specification and abatement contractor bid document development.

- A. Review client's proposed renovation and/or demolition plan.
- B. Generate asbestos specification and bid documents (when applicable).
- C. Review specifications and bid documents with client and revise as needed.
- D. Perform solicitation of asbestos abatement contractors.
- E. Conduct pre-bid meeting. Review specifications/bid documents with prospective contractors, building owner and/or their representatives and perform site walk through.
- F. Review bid submittals with client and make bid award or award recommendations.

Step 3: Asbestos abatement project management and air monitoring.

- A. Schedule asbestos abatement activities based on client needs and EPA / DNREC 10-day notification requirements.
- B. Conduct baseline air sampling, project and final air clearance sampling.
- C. Complete daily project logs, checklist and conduct daily inspections of the abatement activities.
- D. Provide client with final asbestos abatement report for their records.
